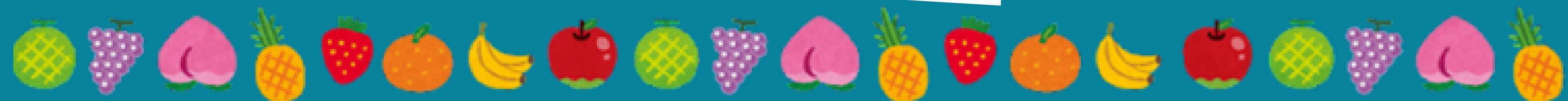

To develop healthy habits and nutrition among children, SAPS made a fruitful environment with the children in the name of Fruit Fest.

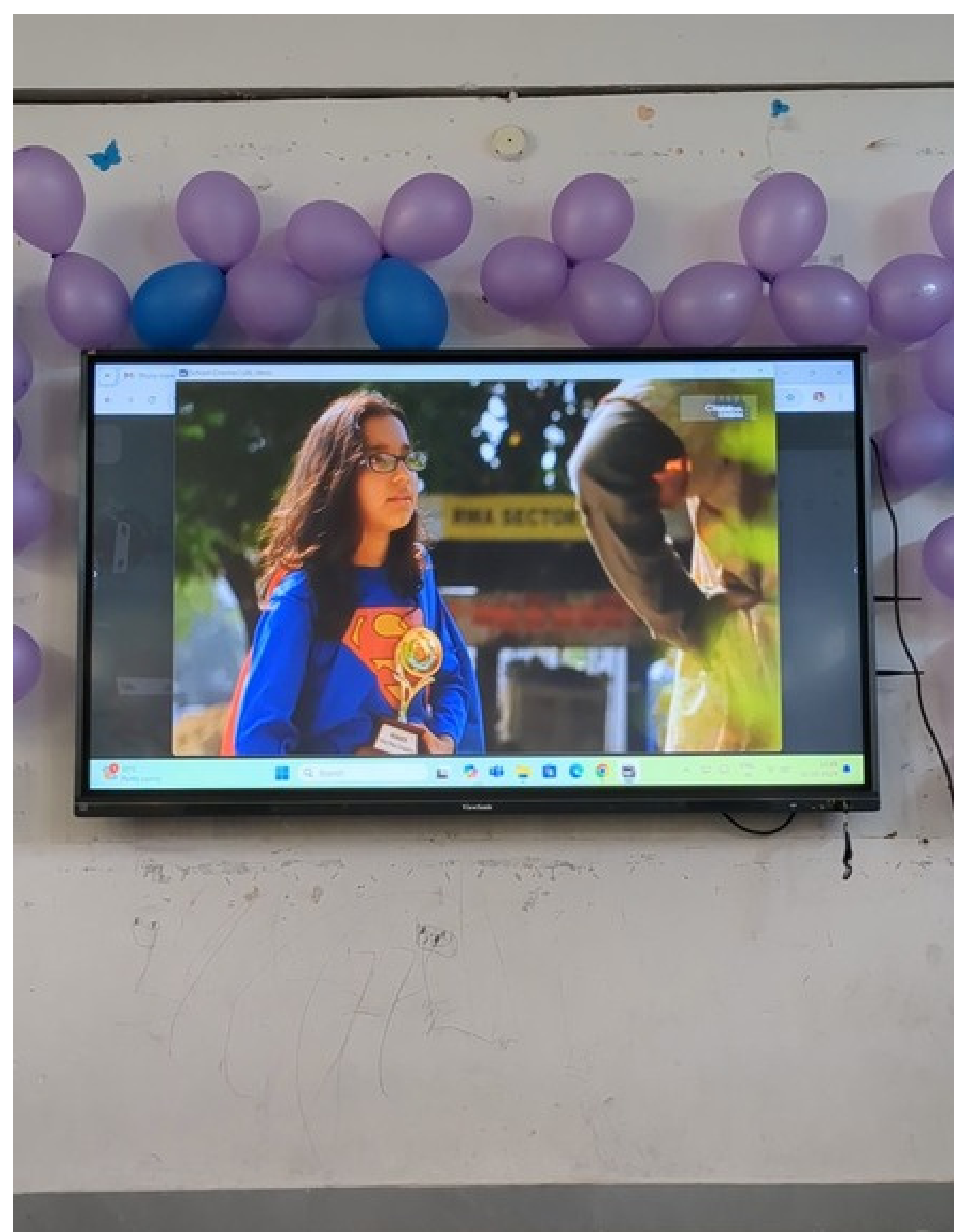
On 25.10.2024 kids came to school in fruit costume and enjoyed the program learning about different fruits.
