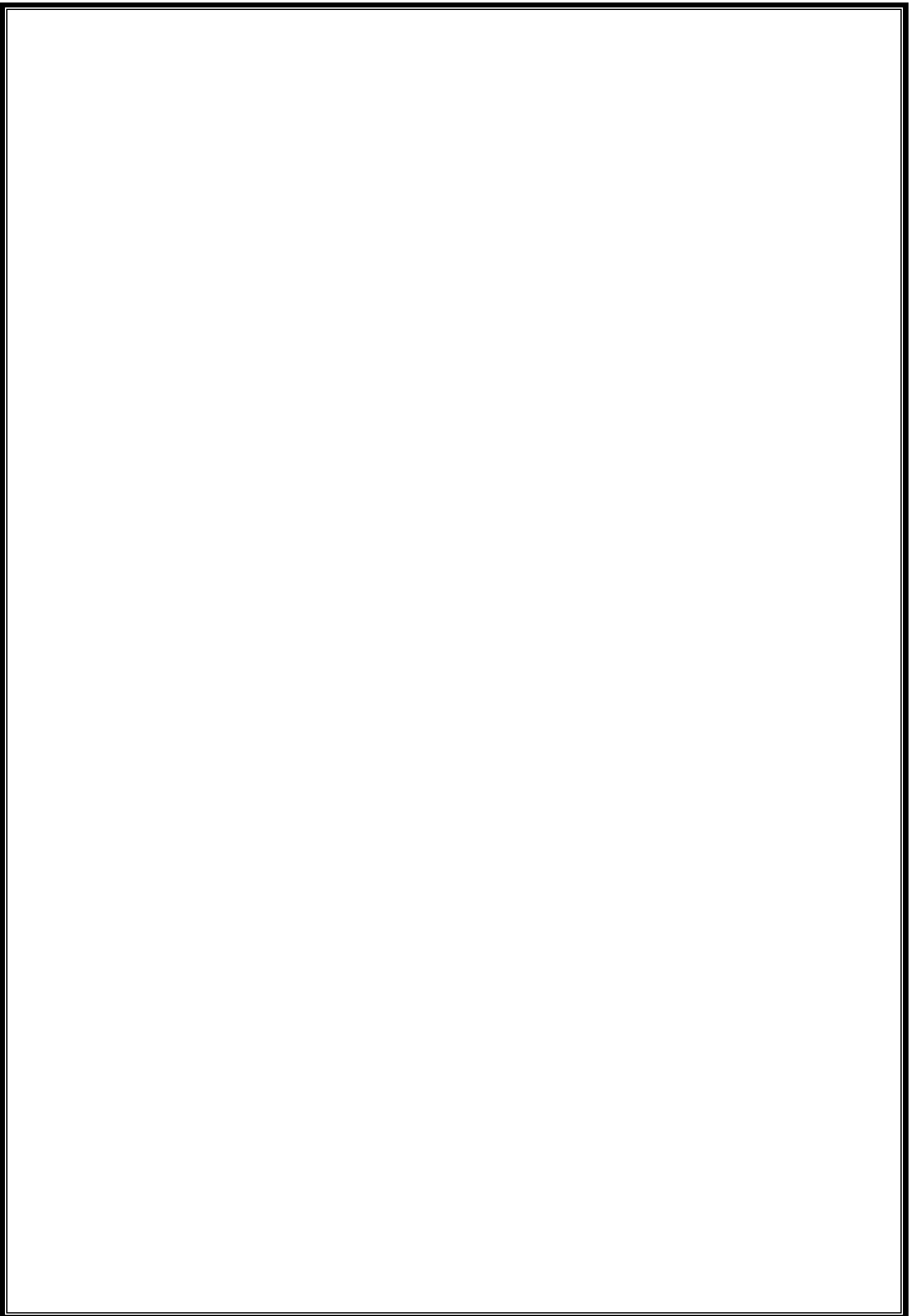

Your child's learning involves and revolves around an effective partnership between home & school. We know the stronger the partnership is the more children will benefit.

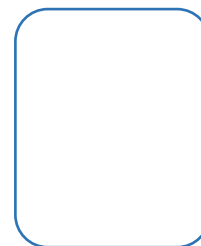

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

1.	School Diary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make effective use of the school diary as a means of communication. • Bring the school diary to the school every day.
2.	Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure to maintain a minimum of 90% attendance as expected by the school. • Ensure to produce a doctor's certificate for absence due to sickness for more than 3 days. • Know that the absence of student on examination days will be considered as leave and the student will not be able to re-take the examination on any other day.
3.	Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure that the right uniform is worn as prescribed by the school. • Wear a black shoes & a fresh pair of black socks every day. • Avoid wearing expensive ornaments (gold, silver) to school & understand that the school will not be responsible for any loss of the same. For girls, white ribbons, must be used to tie the hair neatly. • Avoid wearing smart watch to school; wear ID card compulsory to school on all days. • Sports uniform must be worn on Wednesday & Friday with white shoes and a fresh pair of white socks.
4.	ECA Classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yoga - Bring yoga mat compulsory on yoga periods. • Girls must wear leggings compulsorily. • Taekwondo - Bring taekwondo uniform. • Dance - Girls must wear leggings compulsorily. • Silambam - Girls must wear leggings compulsorily. • Boxing - boxing kit must be brought to class. • Archery - Archery kit must be brought to class. • Karate - Bring Karate uniform.
5.	Speech/Spoken Skills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be polite, courteous and respectful while talking to teachers, friends and visitors. English is the campus language.
6.	Peer interaction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be friendly, helpful and considerate. • Know that abusive language, bullying and harassment of peers are banned in the school.
7.	Discipline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain silence while walking in the corridors, moving up and down the stairs, inside the library, during the assembly and when special functions are held in the school, • Give room for teachers and visitors to pass by while walking in the Corridors or on the stairs. • Do not go out of the classroom unnecessarily after each period. • Go to activity venues silently in an orderly manner without disturbing other classes. • Know that substitute periods are not free periods. Wait for the proxy teacher to come without disturbing the other classes by making too much noise.
8.	Punctuality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be punctual in attending assembly, reaching activity classes, returning from activity classes, house meeting, completion and submission of CW & HW assignments to teachers and all activities of the school.

9.	Behaviour-Not allowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leaving class rooms without permission from teacher. • Possession of mobile phones. • Posting and debating unauthorized or other written materials on school grounds. • Fighting and causing injuries. • Immoral/obscene usage of language or gestures. • Indulging in forgery/theft / cheating/copying the work of another student or source. • Damaging school/class/peer property.
10.	Health & Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the toilets & wash areas with care. • Wash hands before and after eating, after using the toilet and after playing. • Carry a hand napkin every day. • Keep nails neat and clipped. • Comb hair neatly and periodically get it trimmed. • Keep hair free of lice, maintain and keep it clean. • Use spoon while eating food and napkin to clean hands after wash. • Avoid oily sweets and snacks and do not bring junk food or snacks to school. • Eat fresh fruits every day. • Avoid bringing chocolates to school and avoid eating them frequently. • Do not attend school when affected by contagious diseases. • Undergo first aid in the school when injured in the ground/inside/outside classroom. • Keep the school campus "PLASTIC FREE".
11.	Respect for School Property	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that vandalizing school property is a serious offence. • Use all the facilities provided to you with care. • Know that school is a space for learning, show respect to it by taking care of it in every way.
12.	Home Work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Note down the fixed homework timetable provided by teachers of each subject. • Complete and submit the homework on time as it is a part of internal assessment. • Co-operate if the teacher makes a note in the diary in case of non-submission of homework in time.
13.	School Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carry books and notebooks according to time table only. • Strictly avoid carrying heavy bags. • Strictly avoid trolley / heavy bags.
14.	School Transport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be punctual to the bus stop to board the bus on time. • Do not stand in the moving bus; always be seated. • Do not quarrel and make noise and divert the driver's attention. • Co-operate with teachers on bus duty. • Do not put your hands or head outside the window of the bus. • Do not get down in any other stop other than yours. In case of such a situation, furnish a letter from the parent to the class teacher.

TRANSPORT RULES

- Students must be at the bus stop at least 10 minutes before the scheduled time.
- Students should stand in a queue and board the bus in an orderly manner.
- Students must follow the instructions of the driver and bus attendant at all times.
- Students should remain seated while the bus is moving and must not stand or move around.
- Do not extend hands, head, or any objects outside the bus window.
- Shouting, fighting, or creating disturbance inside the bus is strictly prohibited.
- Students must keep the bus clean and should not throw waste inside or outside the bus.
- Eating inside the bus is not allowed.
- Do not damage bus seats or other property.
- Do not distract the driver while the bus is moving.
- Students must carry their school ID card.
- Board and get down only after the bus stops.
- Use only the allotted bus and stop.
- Parents must inform the school if the student is not using the bus.
- Misbehaviour may lead to cancellation of the transport facility.

LIBRARY RULES

- Maintain silence in the library.
- Handle books carefully.
- Do not write or tear pages from books.
- Return books on or before the due date.
- Keep the library clean and tidy.
- Bring your library card when borrowing books.
- Do not misplace books; keep them in the proper place.
- Follow the instructions of the librarian.
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the library.
- Late return of books may result in a fine.

REQUEST TO PARENTS

- Co-operate with school policies and regulations.
- Ensure that the child has a minimum of 90% attendance.
- Send the child in neat uniform and maintain good personal hygiene.
- Update the contact numbers to school for any emergency.
- Inform school if the child suffers from any family illness/allergy.
- Provide appropriate medication during sickness.
- Send healthy and wholesome lunch and nutritious snacks.
- Send a napkin and a spoon for lunch.
- Equip the child with an umbrella or raincoat during rainy days.
- Check the school diary regularly for any updates on homework/test schedules/any other communication and respond when required.
- Be regular in payment of fees.
- Encourage children to complete the projects and submit them on time.
- Co-operate to send the items requested by the teachers for any academic activity.
- Sign the test notebooks that are sent home through the child at regular intervals.
- Ensure that your child boards the school bus on time.
- Contact the school if the child is late from school without prior information.
- Encourage the child's participation in co-curricular events, competitive exams, and programs of the school.
- Communicate to the class teachers through school diary when you require any permission for the child to come late, take leave, or any change of bus stop.
- Communicate to the concerned teacher through the diary/letter if the class work or test papers are not corrected or assessed for more than 10 days from the date of writing.
- Adhere to the schedule provided to meet the teachers.
- Avoid contacting teachers on their personal mobile phones. Try to meet them in person by setting up a meeting time at school (4.00 p.m-5.00 p.m.).
- Sign the school diary regularly.

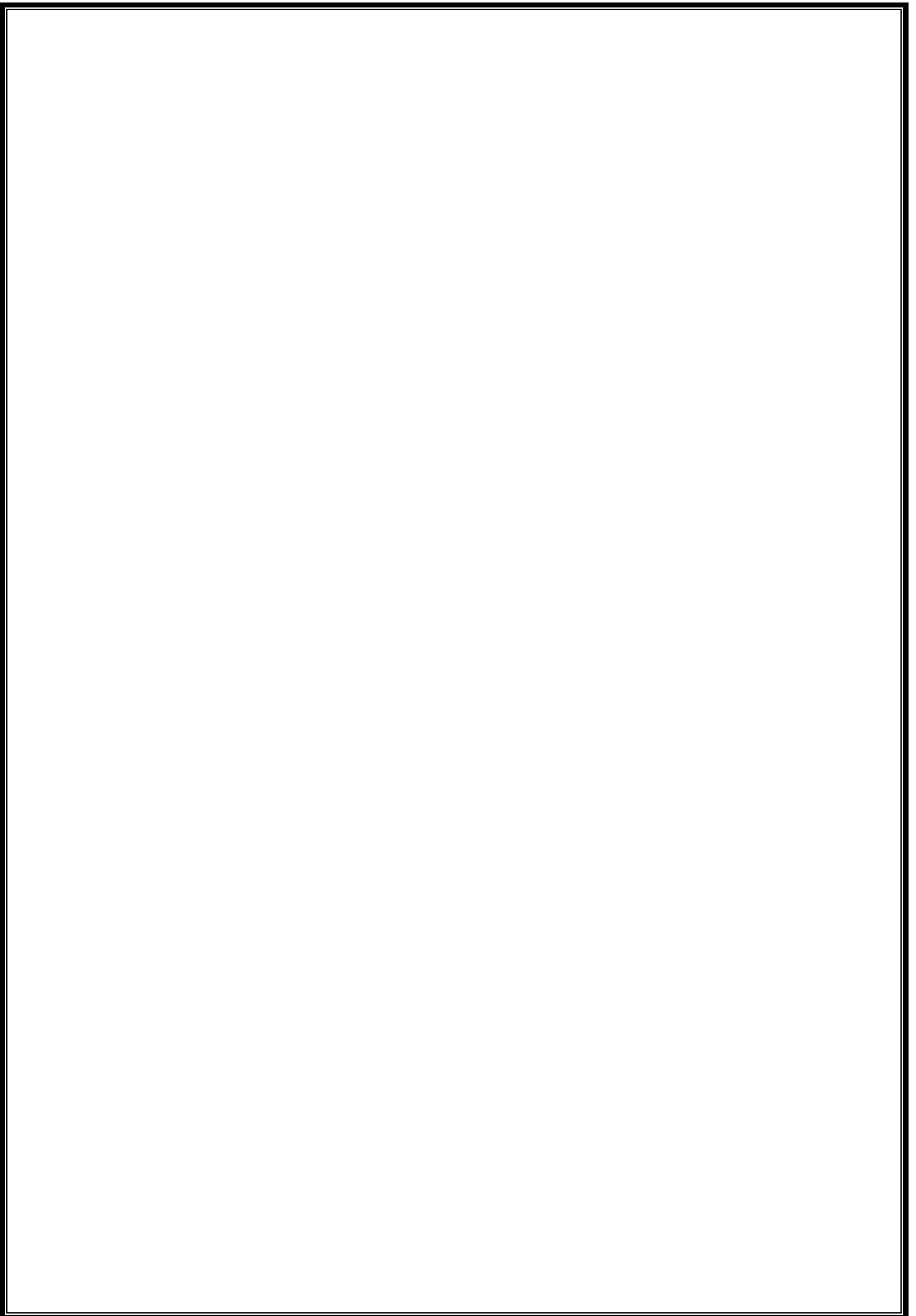

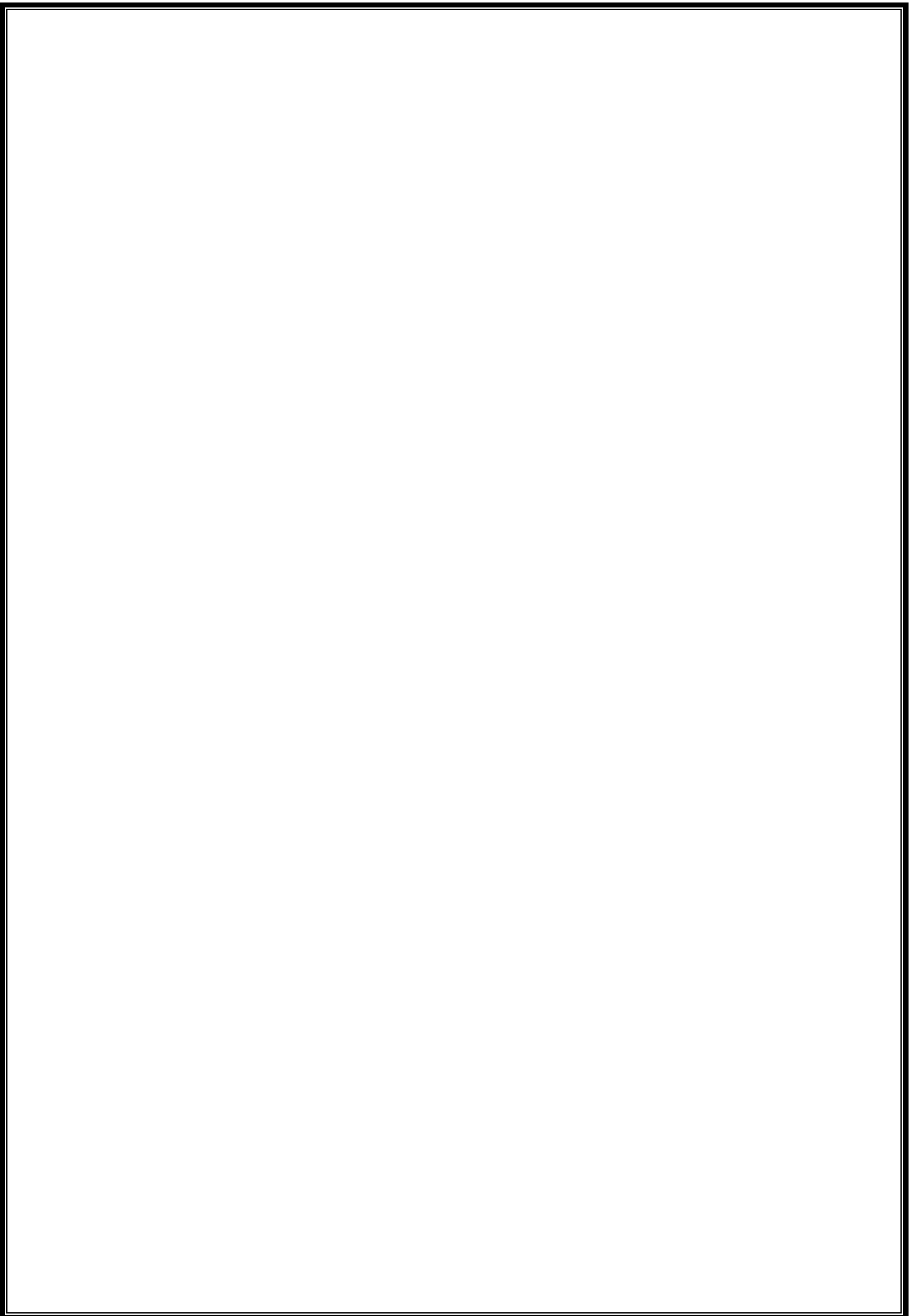
